Mayor's Message

The summer season has finally arrived, and the Village has a number of exciting events planned. Although the forthcoming events are described in detail else-

where in this issue, I want to highlight some points. If you have never been to the Pomona Cultural Center on Rt 306 just north of Pomona Rd, now is a perfect opportunity to visit this special place. The opening reception for the summer exhibition will take place on Saturday June 14th starting at 6 pm. As well as meeting the artists and sampling the gourmet fare catered by Frances Arsa Artha, there will be a Flamenco performance with lan Banks, our Deputy Mayor, playing guitar. The historic Pomona Cultural Center is a real gem, and even if you can't make the opening on the 14th you can visit while the exhibition is running. The Cultural Center is open Friday through Sunday every week from 2 - 6pm. The exhibition will run until July 26th.

The next event planned is the annual Fish-In. This popular event will take place on June 29th at Fairty Pond in Secor Park. Lou Cohn and Jeff Rosen will be on hand to assist the anglers and weigh the fish. The competition is for children up to 13 years old,

and prizes will be awarded in several categories. The recreation committee always does a terrific job in organizing this, and other, events, and we should all be thankful for the time and effort that they give to the village.

The second Pomona Music Festival and Craft Fair will be held on Sunday July 13th at Village Hall. We will also celebrate the 40th anniversary of the incorporation of the village at this event. The featured artists at the summer exhibition are from SALUTE, an organization that supports women in the arts. The group is composed of professional artists presenting artwork in painting, drawing, hand-pulled prints, photographs and sculpture. The group has created special works for this exhibition representing the essence of summer. The opening reception on June 14th will also feature a live flamenco music and dance performance.

The artists of Salute are mostly professional artists who exhibit their work widely. The group was established in 1974 and has over 120 active members. Both men and women are members, although the group is predominantly women from Bergen County, Rockland County and surrounding areas. The group sponsors four art exhibitions annually, in addition to art workshops and general meetings. The members frequently meet in each other's home to critique their artwork. Their support extends

to the community in the form of scholarships they provide to deserving high school art students planning to focus on the arts in college.



FLAMENCO DANCE

Flamenco is a Spanish musical style characterized by strong, rhythmic undertones and accompanied by a passionate style of dance. The origins of flamenco date back to the mid 1700's and evolved out of Andalusia, a region in Spain. Through the years there were many adaptations, and various styles evolved through the contributions of other regions in Spain. Eventually flamenco became the predominant style and flourished as a musical genre.

The Pomona Cultural Center will present another flamenco performance featuring Pomona's Deputy Mayor, Ian Banks. An accomplished guitarist, Mr. Banks has focused on the music of the flamenco performance, and performs frequently with his dance troupe throughout the New York area. The Pomona Cultural Center is proud to present this unique and special performance again.
